### Ready, Set, Go...Make Disciples!

**“And the things that you have heard from me among many witnesses, commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.” 2 Timothy 2:2**

Aggrey Cove (Dennis and Vania’s home in Monrovia) was bustling as 11 CRCA pastors and evangelists from three different regions arrived excited and ready for a week long intensive evangelism training and strengthening. Earlier this year, CRCA support staff members met in the very same location to pray and seek God’s direction for the future of Christian Revival ministries. Two goals became apparent for us as we continue to push forward—strengthening the existing ministry, as well as both the local and global expansion of our church planting efforts. Part of the specific detail of how to accomplish those goals included tripling our evangelism and discipleship work by adding two more Jesus Film teams. God has been reminding us that as we keep our eyes fixed on Christ, emphasizing His Great Commission through evangelism and discipleship, everything else will fall into proper place.

The group started their mornings with exercise, personal devotion times, and group worship. CRCA Mission Director, Dennis Aggrey, was able to enlist the teaching support of brothers and sisters in Christ from Great Commission Movement of Liberia. They looked once again into the beauty of the Gospel—this God who has power to raise the dead and transform lives. Brother Anastis Johnson and the Great Commission team taught various sessions on such themes as “The Power of the Holy Spirit”, “How to use the Jesus Film and other tools to share the Gospel”, “The Importance of follow-up”, and “How to reach out to Muslims”. Dennis was able to remind the team of the heart of CRCA for the lost and to encourage the teams that they would have the full support of Christian Revival. They were also challenged by the goal for each Jesus Film team to show the film 8 or more times per month. In between training sessions the group was able to practice what they were learning by going into the communities on Duport Road to share the Gospel and their own testimonies of how Jesus has changed their lives. They also began inviting people to the showing of the Jesus Film that would be right in their very community later in the week.

All the equipment for three Jesus Film teams was put together, tested, checked, and prepared. CRCA Jesus Film Team jackets were distributed. Prayers of thanksgiving were lifted up. The teams and the equipment were committed to God and we asked for the blessing of the salvation of many souls. By the end of the week, the group divided into two and showed the Jesus Film in two different locations on Duport Road. Many people attended the two showings and some indicated a desire to follow Jesus. Follow up plans were put in place by inviting the new believers to local churches and Bible studies and by getting their contact information in hopes of staying connected.

The final and official commissioning took place on Sunday morning at Monrovia Christian Revival Church. We were blessed to have Pastor Stanley Yanquoi and his wife, Gruly, (both working with The Great Commission Movement of Liberia) join us for service. Pastor Stanley shared about the similarities between a new church and a newborn baby; just as a baby needs special care and attention, protection and affection to survive, so it is with new believers. At the end of the service the Jesus Film teams and their families were asked to come forward for prayer and commissioning. We pray truly that God will bless them as they carry the equipment with them and the Holy Spirit inside of them that they will bear much fruit in the name of Jesus Christ and to the glory of the Father!
